
Student Satisfaction Survey



























The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted for the session 2018-19, 85.40 per cent students agreed that subject knowledge of the teachers are well versed with their respective subjects and 100 per cent were of the opinion that the faculty is well aware of the objectives of paper taught. 74.82 per cent voted that the communication of teachers is very good and 19.71 voted good. 99.64 per cent students agreed that teachers complete their syllabus in time. Students were happy to respond that 74.09 per cent students agreed that teachers motivate the students towards improvement. The academic environment of the college is considered good by the students. Students said that achieve subject clarity after the paper is being taught. 86.49 per cent students were happy with the outside class interaction for infrastructure and Lab facilities 70.44 per cent students were highly satisfied while 20.80 per cent were satisfied.




In view of the Student Satisfaction Survey conducted for the session 2018-19 and analysis done thereafter, the following actions were taken:


- Although the feedback for Communication skills was satisfactory, yet for further enhancement of the same, the faculty members of the college are encouraged to participate Orientation, Refreshment Programmes, etc. Further, as an initiative of IQAC, communication skill programme was organized in English Language Lab of the College.
- > To enhance the academic environment, the students encouraged and mentored for preparation of one competitive exams and rigorous running of remedial classes.
- For outside class interaction between the faculty and the student, IQAC emphasizes on Mentor-Mentee meetings
- For extension of infrastructure and Lab facilities, new projectors were installed, reading room in the library was extended, new equipment's in the lab were installed.
- > Health being an important aspect, proposal for Indoor Stadium was put forward.








































For the session 2018-19, teaching learning feedback was taken by the teachers. On the suitability of syllabus, 54.17 per cent teachers were of the opinion that syllabus is suitable, still the syllabus needs refinement and updating as and when required. 50 per cent agreed to the sufficient number of prescribed books while 12.50 per cent said that still new additions are required to the stack. 91.67 per cent teachers were satisfied with the infrastructural facilities provided by the college. 95.80 per cent faculty voted towards the conducive teaching and research environment of the college. 87.50 per cent teachers and students agreed to the balance between theory and application balance of the curriculum with clearly defined objectives of the course. A large number of students are comfortable with the conduction of examination by the University. 95 per cent agreed to the friendly attitude of the administration towards teachers. The teachers are free to adopt new


methods and techniques for teaching and the college also provides support to these activities as well as encourage towards project and research facilities. This is the opinion of 88 per cent of teachers. They also agreed that college provide adequate funding and support for being updated. Maximum teachers found the process for professional development being fair.




The following actions were undertaken after the teaching learning feedback for the session 2018-19:


- > The number of reference books were added in each subject keeping in mind the ratio of teachers to availability of content

- > Teachers are free to adopt new teaching techniques and methods for which they are given a letter of appreciation by the college.






















For the session 2018-19, Parent's feedback was taken online as well as offline by sending the forms to them through students. 90.91 per cent parents voted that it's a matter of pride that their ward is studying in DAV PG College. However, with regular updation of website 46.75 per cent disagreed but still 29.87 per cent agreed to it that website is informative and regularly updated. 90.91 per cent parents were of the view that college administration is cooperative and communication with the principal is easy was agreed by 81.82 per cent parents. 89.61 per cent agreed that the knowledge base of their ward is improving after being admitted to college. Still 2.60 per cent have not agreed to it. When it comes to conducive learning atmosphere in the college, 93.51 per cent agree to it. 94.81 parents agreed towards security of their ward in campus. Thus, parent's feedback gave the college a positive boost to work, however, college will definitely strive towards the room's left and taken care of.




The following actions were taken by the college:

- 2. The parents were satisfied with the security provision of their ward in the college. However, new CCTV cameras were also installed in addition to already existing


ALUMNI FEEDBACK


























As a regular practice of the college, an Alumni feedback is collected in the college Alumni meet for the session 2018-19. As per the feedback of Faculty of Commerce, 66.22 per cent students found the admission procedure to be very good and 33.78 supported them by voting it as good. Feedback for placement was kept as 40.54 per cent to be satisfactory and 31.08 per cent alumni found it good. However, 12.16 per cent alumni were of the view that it still requires improvement. 47.30 per cent alumni said that fee structure is good. For research work 54.05 Alumni found the library environment to be congenial and 22.97 per cent found it very good. Academic environment of the college was much appreciated with 60.81 per cent saying it to be very good supported by 21.62 per cent to be good while 17.57 per cent found it satisfactory. Canteen was one factor which was emphasized by our alumnus asking to further increase our canteen. For infrastructure and Lab facilities, 51.35 per cent of our alumni were of the opinion that it is good and much appreciated by 27.03 per cent alumni. Improvement in hostel facilities was asked by 52.70 percent. However, the college Faculty was much appreciated and 60.81 per cent students said that faculty is very good, supported by 31.08 per cent being good. Thus, the overall ranking given by our alumni was 47.30 per cent to be very good and 48.65 to be good with few suggestions for expansion and enhancement.

ACTION TAKEN

In view of the aforesaid feedback given by our Alumni, the following actions were taken by the college on proposal of IQAC:

- In view of the feedback, College has increased the number of text books in ratio of the UG students and reference books in ratio of PG students of various subjects.
- College has increased the stacks in the library as well as it has move towards digitalisation of many books.
- The placement cell of the college encourages and guides the students to qualify for off campus job opportunities and slots were separately allotted for training and preparation of various government exams.
- New equipment's have been purchased for labs
