INTERPRETATION OF STUDENT FEEDBACK SURVEY

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was conducted for the session 2017-18. The data for various departments have been collected and compiled into three faculties which were finally merged for the college. As shown in the above tables and graphs, the following conclusions are drawn-

About the Teacher-

• 81.04% students agreed that the teachers are well versed with their respective subject knowledge and 66.17 % voted that the communication skill of the teachers is very good. 65.06 % students agreed that teachers have very fine

ability to motivate students. Further, 71.75% students opined that the regularity and punctuality of the teacher is very good.69.52% voted that the teachers have the subject clarity of the paper they taught and 60.04% students were also very happy with their course completion. Moreover, 64.68% students voted that teachers had practical knowledge of the subject 76.21% students liked the classroom behaviour of the teacher. Further, 54.09%, 62.27% and 36.99% students were very happy with the teacher's outside class interaction, fairness in evaluation and their computer skills respectively. Thus, 65.24% students appreciated the overall performance of the teachers.

About the Course-


• 28.25% students were of the opinion that the faculty is aware of the objectives of the paper taught. 29.00% of the students agreed that the courses in all the programs running in the college were covered in depth. 48.51% students appreciated the relevance of the paper with practical/lab and 34.39% students voted that references that were suggested by the teachers were useful.


About the Institution-

• 46.10% students felt that admission procedure adopted by the college is very good and 36.62% students voted for good fee structure. The academic environment of the college was considered very good by 45.72% of the students. Around 55% of the students were of the view that the faculty member of the institution is very good. The infrastructure and lab facilities were also appreciated by the students. The institution also provides project guidance, library, canteen and hostel facilities to the students which were also acknowledged. Thus, 52.97% students voted that the overall rating of the college was good.




























- 1. The parents feedback data is collected for eight variables.


































The faculty feedback for the year 2020-2021 collected data on fourteen (14) parameters. On subsequent data analysis the following points were highlighted:


- 1. The majority of the responses fall in the 'Strongly Agree' & 'Agree' category.





























ANALYSIS -

To enhance the quality of the education in the college Alumni feedback is collected on a regular basis. The Alumni Feedback for a year is collected on Eleven (11) different parameters. Some of the main highlights of the Alumni feedback are:

- 1. The maximum number of alumni's have given the highest rating of 'Very Good' for the following parameters Admission Procedure (53.85%), Fee Structure (53.85%), Academic Environment (61.54%), Infrastructure & Lab facilities (30.77.0%), Faculty members (76.92%), Project Guidance (46.15%) & Overall Rating of the College (38.46%).
- 2. The alumni's have given nearly highest response of 'Good' in the category of Library (53.85%),
- 3. The alumni considers the Canteen (30.77%) to be 'Satisfactory'.
- 4. The main concern of the alumni's is the Hostel facilities (53.85%) of the college and Placement (46.15%) which is considered to be 'Unsatisfactory'.

Action Taken Report: 2017-18

- The main concern of the alumni's is the Hostel facilities (53.85%) of the college and Placement (46.15%) which is considered to be 'Unsatisfactory'. The placement cell of the college encourages and guides the students to qualify for off campus job opportunities.
- Similarly the student's feedback also shows that students are not satisfied with the hostel facility of the college. To tackle the problem the college facilitates the students to get accommodation in private hostels around the campus.
- Although majority (more than 68.70%) of the students were of the opinion that the faculty members on regular basis use different ICT tools during their lectures, but then also the college administration provides lots of ICT tools to the faculty members.
- Infrastructure facilities in the form of new smart classes were increased to make students familiar with the ICT tools.
- The highest response of 'Strongly Agree' is obtained for the variable
 'Sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the library'
 followed by 'Tests and Examinations are conducted well in time'
 respectively. More text and reference book have been ordered to
 further inculcate the reading practice in students.
