2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		DAV PG College is admitted to the privileges of Banaras Hindu University, the guidelines and mandate structure regarding various courses which are offered- B. A. Arts (Honors), B. A. Social (Honors), B. Com (Honors), M.A. in Arts, M. A in Social, M. Com and Add on Professional Courses (UGDCA, Certificate Courses etc.) are functional within the given framework of the University. Academic calander and evaluation norms are followed of the university. Academic Governing Committee (AGC) of DAV looks at planning and implementation of the assessment and academic calender. The university has adopted major reform in evaluation by introducing Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and the college has adopted the same. Noteworthy aspects are: 1.Internal evaluation of the students is conducted following the norms suggested by AGC within the framework of BHU. Internal assessment includes tutorials, classroom discussion, students' presentation, assignment and sessional tests. Internal is of 30 marks. Schedule of the internal exam is informed to the students in advance. The checked answer sheet is shown to the students and their grievances are redressed immediately. The marks obtained by the students in internal exam is displayed on departments' notice board. The external is of 70 marks and are conducted by BHU. By faculty members in the beginning of semesters students are informed about the components of assessment process. The marks obtained by the students in internal assessment tests and external exam are uploaded on the University web portal (bhuonline.in) 2.Other annual academic activities are performed prescribed under Academic Calendar- memorial events, departmental seminars, conferences & workshops, curricular & extra-curricular activities, different academic competitions under departmental forums of Students. For example, 10days workshop is organized on GST and Taxation, Workshop on communicative skills, Workshop on Writing skills, Workshop in AIHC & Archelogy on.....etc 3.Students are given field work and practical learning. They do Industrial visit, historical survey, Market oriented surveys and surveys of villages for collecting data regarding branded projects. 4.Teaching is the most important function of academic world undoubtedly effective teaching stimulates learners and brings into being intended outcome. Faculty members at DAV not only teach in the classroom but they do interaction outside the class also and for that matter it is mandatory for each faculty to be available for at least five hours in the college. Students are assigned by the departments tutorials, assignments, project works, seminars, quizzes, group discussions, debates and poetry competitions. These activities provide participatory learning necessarily. Students are individually given guidance for project work/ dissertation, assignments, group discussion, class presentations and class tests. All these activities form the basis for internal assessment to evaluate the outcome of curriculum delivery. Both students and faculty have easy access to e-journals facility in the Main Library, internet facility, subject-specific research journals, magazines, newspapers and books available in the Main and Departmental library.
