




































Comments














































Analysis

On the basis of feedback taken by the students for the session 2022-23, the following conclusions can be drawn:

1. In 'About the Teacher' category students 'Very Good' was the highest response in all the seven variables with highest being in 'Subject Knowledge' followed by 'Subject Clarity'. This feedback suggests that students generally perceive the teacher to have excellent subject knowledge and clarity in presenting the material.

• Consistent High Ratings:

'Very Good' emerged as the highest response across all seven variables. This indicates a consistent positive perception among students in various aspects related to the teacher.

• Top-Ranked Variables:

The variable 'Subject Knowledge' received the highest rating among all seven variables. This suggests that students highly appreciate the teacher's expertise and mastery in the subject matter. Following closely, 'Subject Clarity' ranked as the second-highest variable. This implies that students also value the teacher's ability to convey information clearly and comprehensibly.

• Overall Positive Teacher Evaluation:

The prevalence of 'Very Good' ratings across multiple dimensions implies an overall positive evaluation of the teacher by the students.

2. Based on the feedback collected in the 'About the Course' category for the session 2022-23, it can be inferred:

• High Awareness of Objective:

The variable 'Awareness of Objective of the Paper' received the highest response. This indicates that students are well-informed and aware of the objectives associated with the course. The high rating for 'Awareness of Objective of the Paper' may imply that the course objectives are effectively communicated to students, contributing to their understanding and engagement.

• Student-Centric Methods Appreciated:

Following closely, 'Use of Student-Centric Method' was the second-highest response. This suggests that students value instructional methods that are focused on their needs and engagement.

3. Based on the feedback collected in the 'About the Institution' category, several conclusions can be drawn:

• Strong Academic Environment:

The 'Academic Environment' has performed the best, indicating that students generally find the academic atmosphere within the institution positive and conducive to learning.

• Concerns with Canteen Facilities:

• The feedback suggests that the 'Canteen' facilities have performed the worst. This might indicate dissatisfaction with the quality, variety, or overall experience of the canteen services.


• Lack of Opportunities for Field Survey & Extension Activities:























The date regarding feedback from parents was collected on eight categories of variables. Analysis of obtained data shows that


- 1. In seven out of eight variables response 'Agree' has been given maximum percentage

- 3. The college website is informative and regularly updated has Disagree by 44.6% parents. Only 37.1 % of parents were agreed on this issue which might be a concern for us.




























The alumni feedback for the year 2022-2023 collected data on ten (10) parameters along with overall. Data analysis reveals the following points:

- 1. The majority of the responses fall in the 'Very Good & 'Good' category.
- 2. The 'Very Good' response has the highest percentage for eight variables out of the eleven variables
- 3. The 'Good' response has the highest percentage for one variable (Library) out of the eleven variables
- 4. Approximate 27 percent of students shown their dissatisfaction with the 'Hostel Facilities', 16 percent of students express their dissatisfaction with 'Placement' whereas 15 percent of students are not satisfied with canteen facility in the college.

Action Taken Report on Feedback (2022-23)

Faculty Member

Students' appreciation on delivery of curriculum by teachers and completion of course in time during 2022-23, motivated the faculty members; and the same pattern and delivery mechanism would be continued. Further, it was also decided that our new online platforms 'media center' would be functional in full strength in coming years.

Maximum number of the Alumni were satisfied with the performance of the faculty members. It is indeed a very good sign for the college, so considering this practice as an appreciation the college continued to conduct large number of academic programs such as research methodology workshops, seminars, conferences etc. to uplift the performance of faculty members.

The college administration always used to encourage all the faculty members to participate in various academic activities such as conferences, seminars, workshops etc. to further inculcate the current global competition.

Placement:

About 16 % of the respondents were not satisfied with the placement facilities provided by the college. Although the college is not running professional courses still, we are trying to develop placement facilities at department as well college level.

We also enhancing our student's professional skill through different courses like computer application, communication skills, language lab Hindi Patrakarita and Counseling and Psychotherapy to meet up the challenges of selection and placement.

All the departments of the college were started ne value added courses to sharpen the skill the knowledge of the students which will help them to get job.

Further the college administration reconstituted a 'placement committee' consisting of some senior faculty members. The committee is establishing a linkage with corporate members, entrepreneurs and our alumni to promote placements of our college.

Hostel

Considering the remark about hostel facilities provided by the college, the administration has submitted a proposal to construct Boys and Girls hostel in the college to UGC. Once the proposal is finalized by UGC, the problem regarding hostel will get resolved.

Library

The feedback regarding library facility, infrastructure and lab facilities provided by the college was satisfactory, still the college administration always takes prompt and

immediate steps to rectify/ resolve any problem, if any. Renovation and digitalization of the college library has been proposed. Numerous books related to syllabus, latest journals, magazines etc. are purchased by the college administration on regular basis.

In the process of digitalization of the library, development and maintenance of a separate webpage for library has been proposed for smooth functioning.

As such, Labs are equipped with computers, podiums, air conditioners etc. but they are updated with latest configurations/ technologies, Wi-fi facilities etc. on regular basis.

Website:

45 percent of the parents shows dissatisfaction with college website. To resolve this issue regular update and necessary modification of the website has been started now. To make the college website more user friendly it is being developed in Bilingual mode.
