V11: Overall Rating of the College



The alumni feedback for the year 2023-2024 collected data on ten (10) parameters along with overall. Data analysis reveals the following points:

1. The majority of the responses fall in the 'Good & 'Satisfactory' category.
2. The 'Good' response has the highest percentage for four variables out of the eleven variables whereas 'Satisfactory' response has highest percentage for five variables out of eleven variables.
3. None of response has the highest percentage in 'Very Good' category out of the eleven variables.
4. Approximate 60 percent of alumni shown their dissatisfaction with the 'Hostel Facilities', and 'Placement' whereas 30 percent of students are not satisfied with canteen facility in the college.

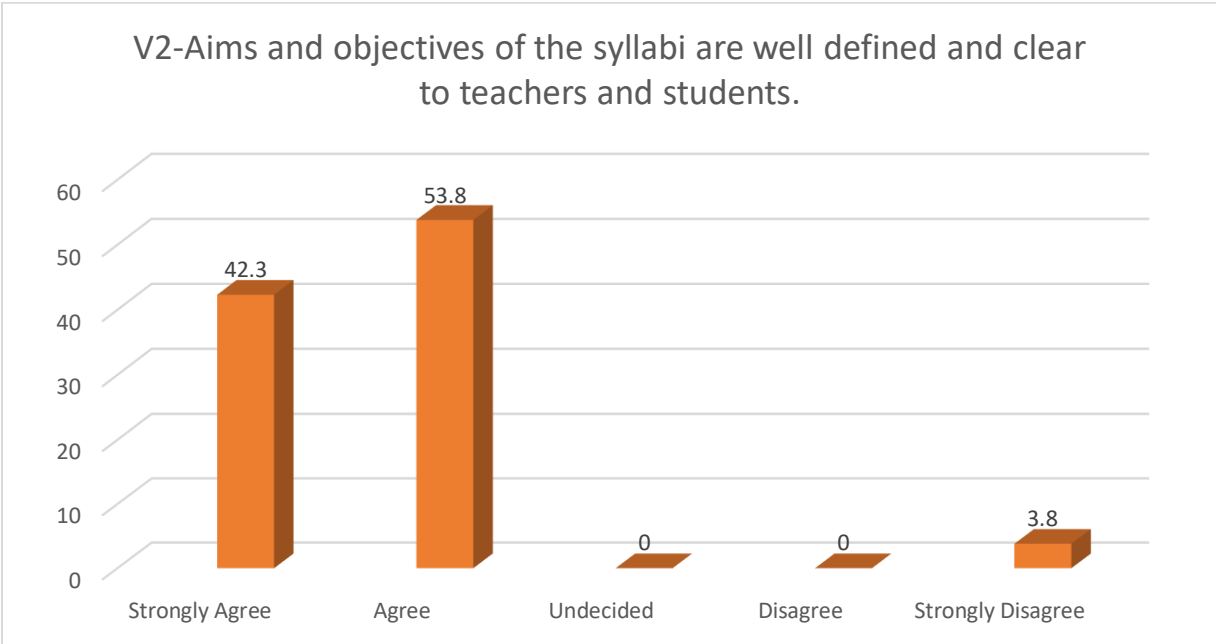
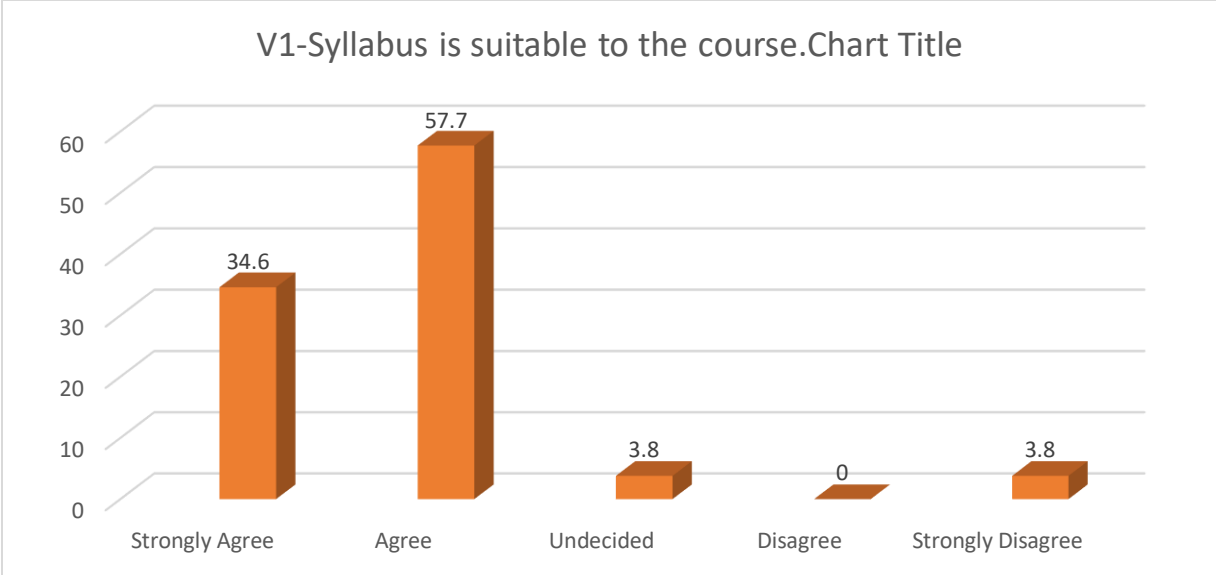

4. The highest response of 'Strongly Agree' is obtained for three parameters namely the Infrastructural facilities, such as teacher's rooms, class rooms, reading rooms and toilets are available in the College'; 'The environment in the department/College is conducive to teaching and research; and Tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus.

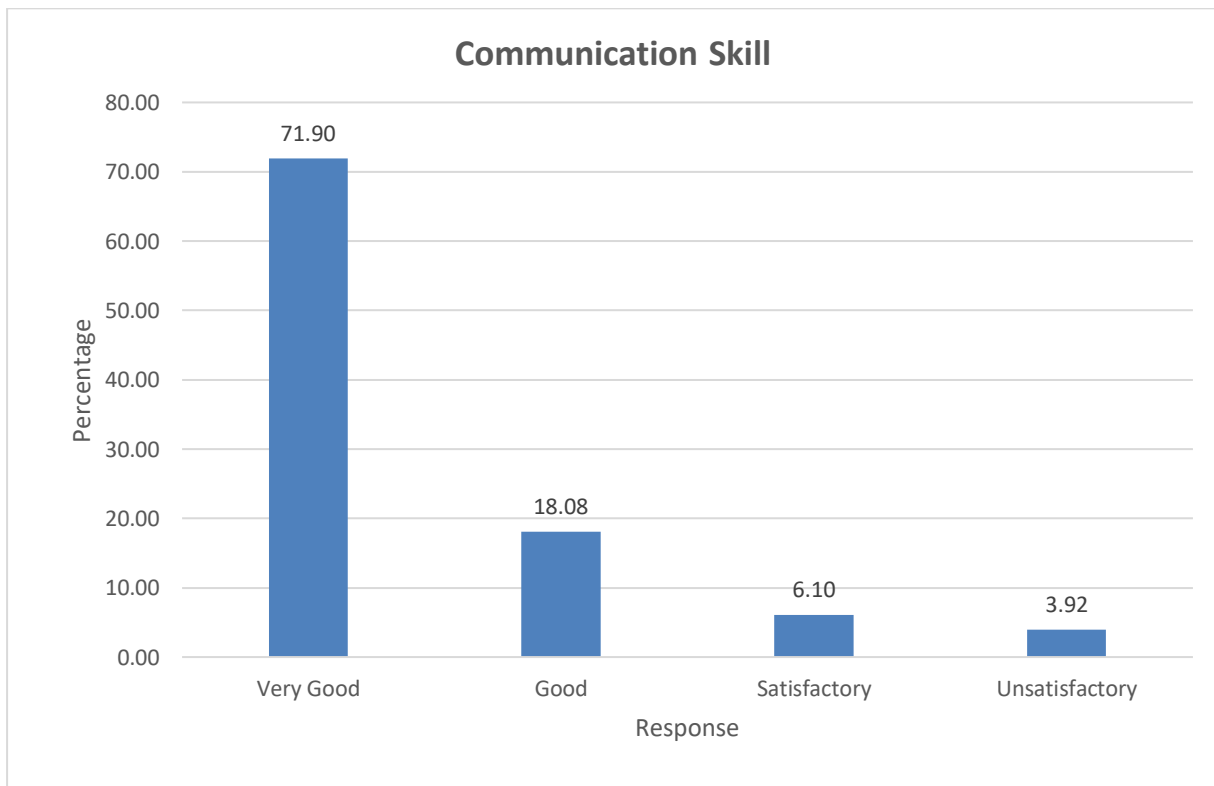
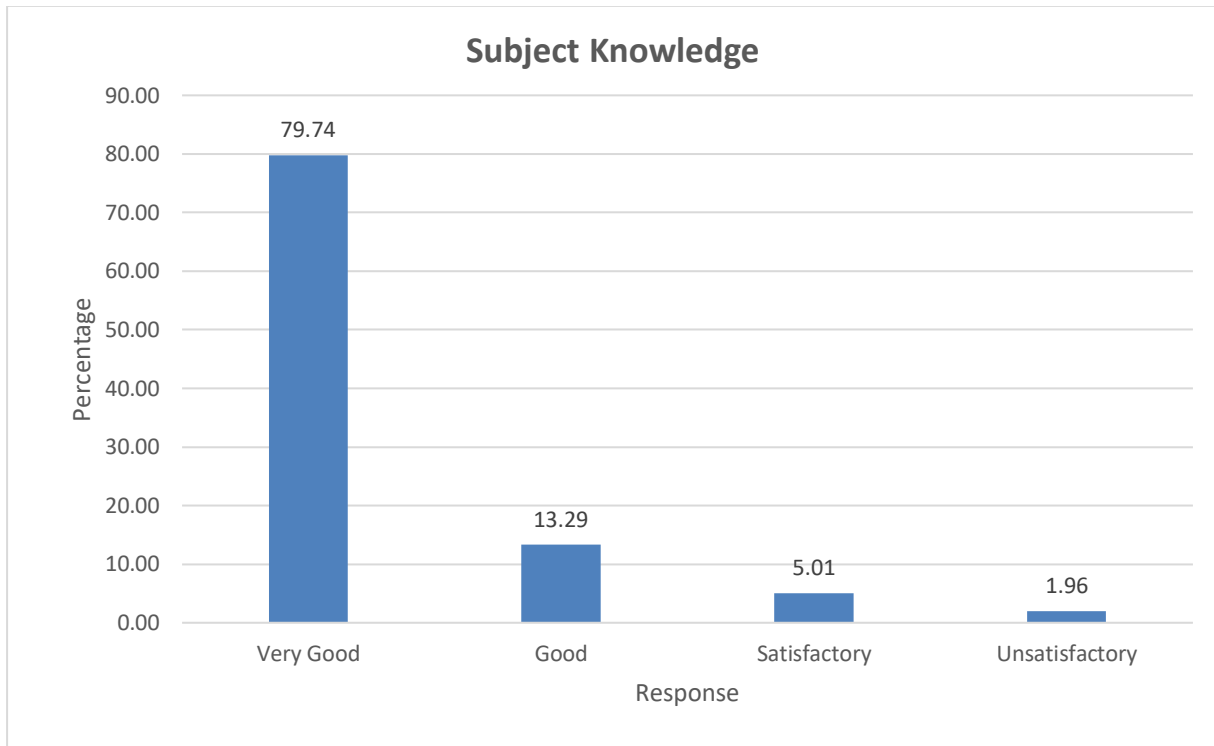

A survey was conducted to analyse students' satisfaction with their teachers based on specific criteria. The survey responses were categorized into four levels: Very Good, Good, Satisfactory, and Unsatisfactory.

Key Findings

1. Subject Knowledge received the highest "Very Good" response at 79.74%, indicating teachers excel in their understanding and delivery of subject matter.
2. Subject Clarity followed with 72.98% rating it as "Very Good," showcasing clear communication and explanation skills.
3. Use of ICT Tools garnered the lowest "Very Good" response at 42.27% and the highest "Unsatisfactory" response at 15.25%, highlighting an area requiring significant improvement.

The survey results suggest that while teachers demonstrate excellent subject knowledge and clarity, the effective integration of ICT tools in teaching is a challenge.

Improving the use of ICT tools in teaching is crucial for meeting student expectations and enhancing overall satisfaction. By implementing improvements in Use of ICT tools, educational institutions can bridge the current gap and foster a more interactive and technology-driven learning environment.

Analysis

Analysis On the basis of feedback taken by the students for the session 2023-24, the following conclusions can be drawn:

1. In the "About the Teacher" category, the feedback shows that the highest response was "Very Good" across all seven subcategories. The most highly rated aspects were "Subject Knowledge," which received the highest score, followed closely by "Subject Clarity." However, the use of ICT tools received the lowest "Very Good" rating at 48.55%. This suggests that while the teacher's knowledge and clarity are well-appreciated, there may be room for improvement in incorporating more technology into teaching practices.
2. In the "About the Course" category, feedback was gathered for three variables: *Awareness of the Objective of the Paper*, *Completion of the Course*, and *Use of Student-Centric Methods*. The responses indicate that the highest "Yes" rating was observed for *Awareness of the Objective of the Paper*, suggesting that students felt well-informed about the course objectives. This was followed by positive responses regarding the *Use of Student-Centric Methods*, showing an appreciation for engaging, student-focused approaches. Finally, *Completion of the Course* received the thirist highest "Yes" response.
3. In the "About the Institution" category, the feedback reveals that *Academic Environment* received the highest "Very Good" response, with 60.69% of participants rating it positively. This highlights a strong appreciation for the institution's academic setting. On the other hand, the *Canteen* received the lowest "Very Good" rating at 34.10%, indicating that improvements in this area might enhance overall satisfaction with campus facilities.

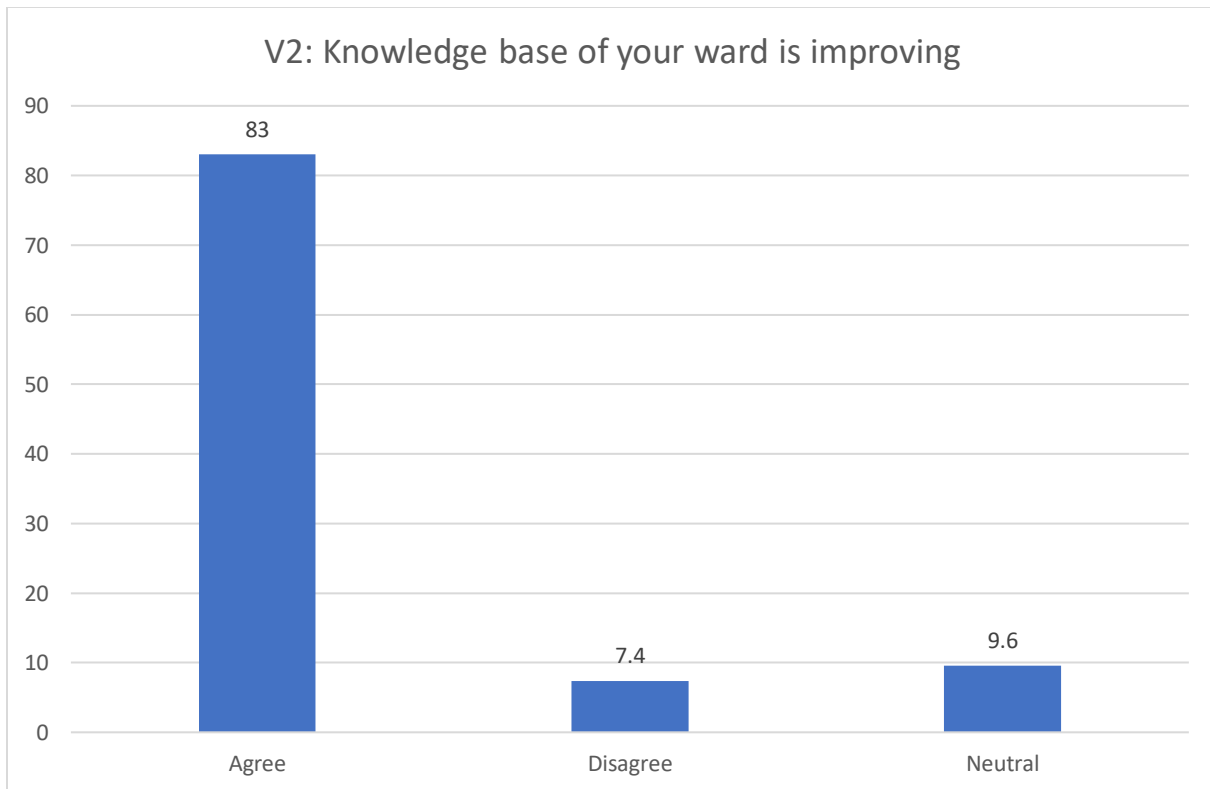
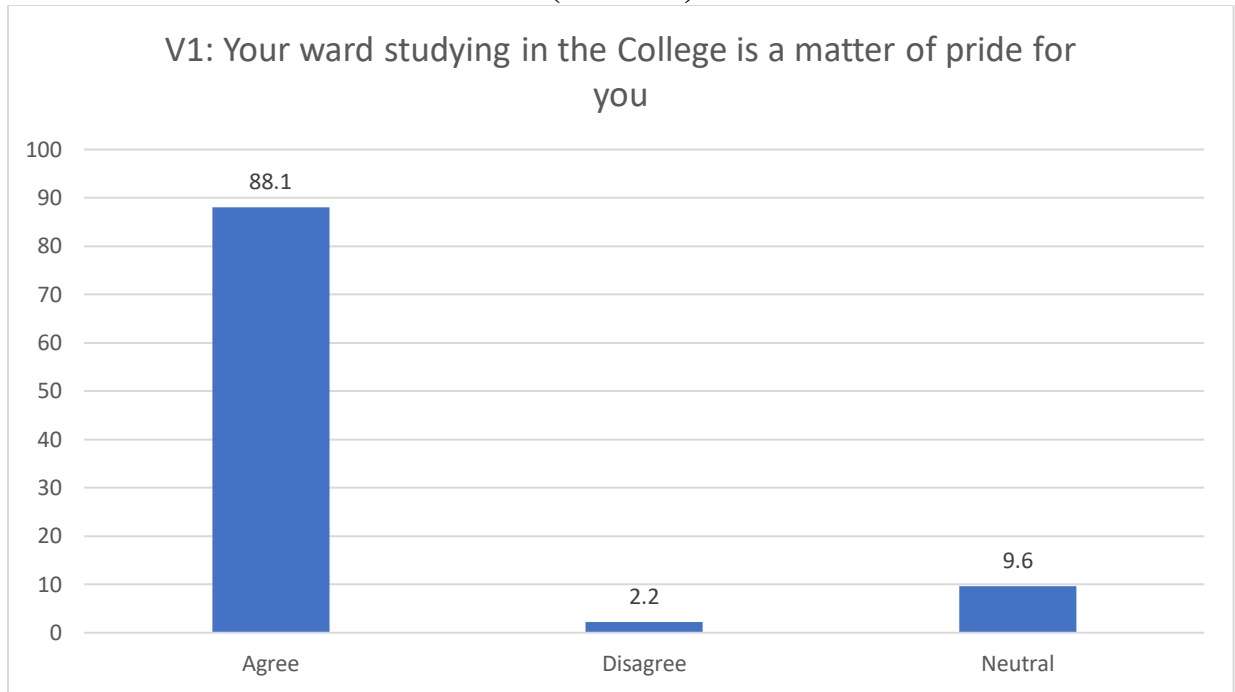

The data regarding feedback from parents was collected on eight parameters. Analysis of obtained data shows that

1. In seven out of eight variables response 'Agree' has been given maximum percentage
2. The variable 'The college is a secured campus for your ward' highest percentage of Agree response (88.9%). It is followed by variables 'Your ward studying in the College is a matter of pride for you' (88.1 %).
3. Only 22.2 percent of parents were agreed on issue of satisfaction with hostel facility which might be a concern for us.
